Griffyn was chosen to be part of the "Crew" of the HMCS Oriole on Thursday Sept. 14th/ 23. The vessel departed from Hamilton and arrived in Toronto manned by a crew of 21.

The HMCS Oriole is the oldest and longest serving ship in the RCN. Launched in 1921 and commissioned in 1954, Oriole remains true to its original design as an ocean racing yacht. Oriole excels in its mission providing leadership training for sailors and visiting ports of calls as goodwill ambassador for the RCN. The Oriole is 200 feet long and carries a 200 ft. mast. Her maximum speed is 8 knots (15km/h; 9.2mph) while under power, she can exceed this speed under sail when conditions are right for her. Her home port is Halifax N.S..
