Towards Susan's Ordination: Important date for the Congregational Diary from The Deacons Board-TODAY at 2 pm

Over the last two years, Susan has been assiduously pursuing her path to Ordination. The next step is around the corner. It is with The Gathering of Baptists that Susan seeks credentialing. Following The Gathering's protocol, it is the local Congregation (utilizing its own process) that ordains, whereupon The Gathering renders a decision to hold the person's credentials.

All members and adherents of MacNeill are invited to a special congregational meeting scheduled for Sunday February 25 at 2PM in the sanctuary. Susan already has provided (via e-mail and in print) her statement of faith; it is necessary that attenders will have read it in advance. That afternoon, Susan will provide a brief overview/review and then engage us in a question-and-answer conversation whereupon members and adherents will vote on a two-part motion. Note that members of The Gathering of Baptists will be invited to this meeting in a non-voting role.

While this meeting will also be on ZOOM, it is hoped that as many as possible will come in person. If unable to attend, there is the opportunity to assign a proxy vote, by contacting either Bob Bond or Heather Hobbs (Deacons Co-Chairs) either by phone or e-mail (contact information in the church directory). The following are the ballot questions:

- 1. That the congregation of MacNeill supports Susan's request for ordination and agrees that MacNeill can convene a Service of Ordination to take place in Spring 2024: Yes.... No......
- 2. That the congregation of MacNeill supports requesting that Susan's credentials be placed with The Gathering of Baptists: Yes No
